



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Roundabout on North Tegner Street to carry detour traffic in mid-July for one week

In the middle of July, northbound US 93 (North Tegner Street) traffic will be temporarily detoured onto the new roundabout at the northern end of the Wickenburg Interim Bypass. The detour is anticipated to be in place for one week. Northbound traffic on North Tegner Street will be shifted to the right and will proceed through the roundabout to continue north on US 93 towards Rincon Road. Southbound traffic will remain on the existing roadway and will not be routed through the roundabout at this time.

The detour is required to allow construction crews to complete work that will tie-in North Tegner Street to the new bypass roadway. The roundabout will ultimately provide access between North Tegner Street and the new bypass roadway, set to be open for travel by February 2010.

Drivers are encouraged to give themselves extra travel time and to be prepared to slow down approaching the work zone. While ADOT strives to inform the public about planned roadway restrictions, during any complex construction project, there is a possibility that unscheduled closures or restrictions may occur.
